Re-evaluation Rules for all Streams and Courses

As approved by the 36th Meeting of Academic Council

- 1. A Candidate may, within 15 days of declaration of results, apply for re-evaluation of not more than 2 (two) Papers by paying a fee of Rs. 550/- (Rupees Five Hundred Fifty) only per paper.
- 2. Re-evaluation is not applicable to those candidates who have failed in more than 2 (two) papers.
- 3. The facility for Re-evaluation is not applicable to Practical Examinations Papers.
- 4. Fees should be submitted to the College along with the **Original Mark Sheet** issued by the University.
- 5. The application shall be screened by the Controller of Examinations/Examinations Department and shall be sent to one Examiners others than the ones who have examined the script earlier.
- 6. No retrospective benefits such as awards of Gold Medal, Scholarship, Fellowship, Admission, Promotion, etc. shall be accrued to a Candidate as a result of Re- evaluation.
- 7. Re-evaluation shall not be time-bound process, but all efforts will be made to ensure early declaration of results.
