2014 – 2015 (Summary of various events/ activities)

- (1) The Organisers of the State Level Anthurium Festival at Reiek held from 25th – 27th September, 2014 specially invited the college Cultural Club to perform the Cheraw Dance during the Opening Ceremony.
- (2) To spread the importance and advantages of cleanliness, the College Youth Adventure Club on 10th April, 2015 held a One Day ‘Clean Reiek Peak’ Project in collaboration with the Directorate of Sports and Youth Services, Mizoram.

- (3) In order to promote the spirit of oneness within the State, the College S.U. Choir participated in the M.Z.P. General Conference held at Farkawn.
- (4) The College Organized World Mental Health Day in the College Campus to instigate empathy and help in both the students and the local people.
- (5) World's Consumer Rights Day was observed in the College Campus on 18th March, 2015 for the students and the Community. The aim of this programme is to create awareness on Consumer Rights.
- (6) The College extended help to the Blood Bank, Civil Hospital Aizawl by organizing Blood Donation Camp on 10th April, 2015 in the College Campus. 108 units of blood were donated by students and faculty donors. This project promotes the act of selfless donation of priceless blood in the students.
- (7) The College organized Blood Donation Camp in observation of National Voluntary Blood Donation Day for Blood Bank, Civil Hospital, Aizawl on 1st October, 2015. The Camp was held in the College Hall and 35 units of blood were donated by our students.
- (8) College Classrooms utilized as M.P.S.C. (Mizoram Public Service Commission) Examination Centers for Group 'A' and Subordinate posts.
- (9) The College Faculty Members catered to the needs of the M.P.S.C. Examination in conducting the Exams; Centre Superintendent, Assistant Superintendent and Invigilators.
- (10) The College N.S.S. Unit conducted Anti-Polythene Awareness Campaign by distributing pamphlets on 9th October, 2015 at Khatla. This is a Community Drive against the use of polythene that simultaneously educates the students to avoid use of polythene items.
