### Memorandum of Understanding

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#### Between

#### Youth for Sustainability Clubs, India

and

#### Eco-Club of Government Johnson College, Aizawl, Mizoram

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets the terms and understanding between the Youth for Sustainability, India (hereafter "YfS") and Eco-Club of Government Johnson College (hereafter "the institute") to collaborate as for activities related to SDG 12 and 13.

The scope of this MoU covers the volunteer-driven activities of mutual interest to YfS and the institute and the associated environmentalism and sustainable strategies and social entrepreneurship needs.

# **Expectations and Benefits:**

The above goals will be accomplished by undertaking the following activities

Create a mutual understanding of the strategy and needs of both organizations to enable broader understanding for YfS of the benefits and opportunities of working with the institute and assist the institute's understanding of the benefits and opportunities of working with YfS

Identify synergies between YfS and the institute events, training, and sustainability-driven activities where they relate to environmentalism, sustainability, and social entrepreneurship strategies of YfS

Create opportunities through a volunteer-driven chapter and student coordinators for volunteer-driven activities and projects which translate science into innovative tools or solutions for use by YfS

Act mutually as advocates for environmental and sustainability research, SDGs, and each other, when interacting with decision-makers and other stakeholders

Identify and measure the impact arising from YfS' collaboration with various events under the institute

YfS will assist as outreach and sustainability partners for the activities & events conducted by the institute

30 (thirty) calendar days or such period as agreed otherwise between the parties and thereafter

giving 30 (thirty) calendar days written notice of termination to the other Party in case of

discrepancy and irregularities by either of the Parties.
