- i. 21/04/2022: Govt. Johnson College Hall, where a total of 76 units of blood was donated (58 female, 18 male)
- ii. 07/09/2022: Govt. Johnson College Hall, where a total of 126 units of blood was donated (107 male, 19 female)

7. Number of Special Camping conducted with date, venue and brief report.

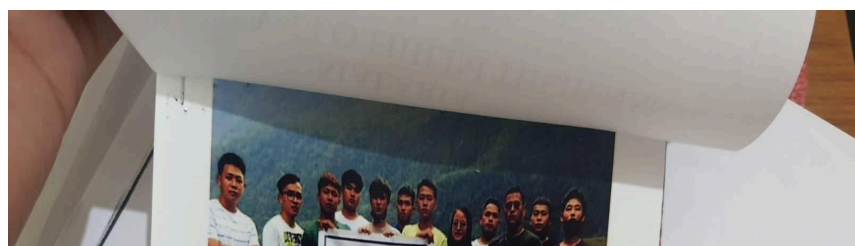
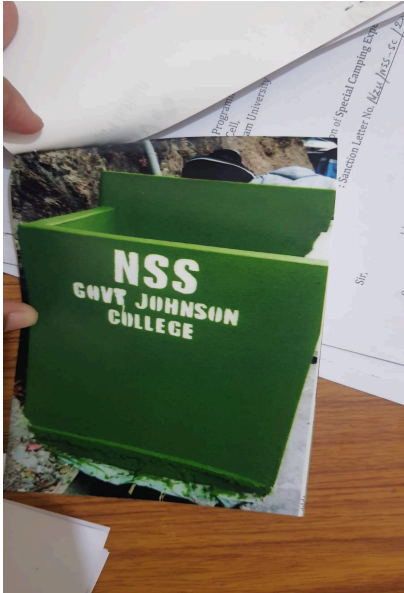
- i. Public Urinals were constructed and awareness campaigns related to anti-tobacco and malaria drives were also organized. Flyers and pamphlets pertaining to these issues were distributed.
- ii. Special Camping at Thiak Village (08/09/2022-14/09/2022): A total of 50 volunteers (36 male, 14 female) and 3 POs(2 male,1 female) participated in the Special Camping Programme under the theme "Water Conservation". Fire Prevention Awareness and Environment Awareness campaigns were conducted. Cleaning of Changte River was also conducted.
