

SEMINAR CUM POETRY READING COMPETITION Organized by Department of English & IQAC Govt. Johnson College Aizawl, Mizoram 22nd March 2023

The Department of English and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Government Johnson College, organized a Seminar cum Poetry Reading Competition on the Occasion of World Poetry Day 2023 on 22nd March 2023 (Wednesday) at 10:30 AM, *Kindling the Fire with Dr. Lalbiakdiki and Poetry Reading Competition*, at the Seminar Hall in the college.

In the First Session (10:30 AM – 11: 30 AM IST), the said resource person Dr. Lalbiakdiki gave a special talk on "Kindling the Fire: Understanding Poetry," wherein she emphasized on the benefits of poetry; touching upon the different forms of poetry, its elements, fundamental rules and its overall emotional effect both objectively and subjectively. Lively discussion was ensued at the end of the lecture. 30 students from II, IV and VI Semesters attended the seminar.

In the Second Session (12:30 PM – 2:30 PM), out of 30 students that attended the said seminar, 22 students participated in the Poetry Reading Competition. The following criterions were laid upon:

- 1. Originality
- 2. Presentation
- 3. Command of Language
- 4. Grammar
- 5. Appropriateness of the title with the content/ subject-matter of the poem.

After poems were read out by the 22 participants, the judges deliberated the results and declared the following as the winners of the competition:
